Allied Chucker and Engineering Co. Conflict Mineral Policy

Allied Chucker supports Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. Allied strives to source responsibly. Our objective is to not produce parts that contain tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold ("Conflict Minerals") that subsidizes the armed conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and its nine adjoining countries in any way. Allied's intention is to comply with Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act and depend upon our suppliers to assist us in our efforts. We require our suppliers to do their due diligence in identifying, assessing and reporting the risks in their supply chain in regards to Conflict Minerals.

Allied may "suspend or discontinue engagement with suppliers where we identify a reasonable risk that they are sourcing from, or linked to, any party providing direct or indirect support to non-state armed groups", if all attempts at mitigation fail. As per Annex II of OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains.

Allied has adopted a risk management plan to prevent the risk of direct or indirect support of non-state armed groups.

Allied will not demand or offer bribes and will resist all solicitation of bribes to conceal or disguise the origin of minerals.
